THE 2025 VINTAGE

BY HENRI LURTON TO HIS FAMILY

Dear Léonce,

If you were still with us, you would be writing with precision in your notebook: **the earliest harvest of the past thirty years**, with the whites starting on August 20 and the reds on September 2. **Small berries across all grape varieties**, the consequence of **a hot, dry year**. Average berry weight: 1.0 to 1.2 grams for Merlot, 0.9 to 1.1 grams for Cabernet Sauvignon. **A low yield of 32.2 hl/ha**, due to the small berry size and fewer berries per cluster. Despite rainfall at the end of August and in September, the berries did not swell. **The sanitary condition at harvest remained remarkable.**

Dear Denise, Dear François,

We experienced **a winter close to seasonal norms**, with no frost despite an early budbreak. Very quickly, a water deficit set in, with little significant rainfall. **Flowering took place in dry, serene conditions**, with very low disease pressure.

The summer drought, intensified by **the heat in June**, led to **significant and early water stress**. Veraison came early and progressed rapidly from mid-July onwards. **A few rainy episodes at the end of August and in September accompanied the end of the cycle, without ever compromising the balance.**

Dear Dad,

One day I asked you whether you had ever experienced conditions like 2005. You answered “1928.” You were still only a child. I can tell you that if you had tasted 2025, you might have nuanced your response. **The extreme climatic conditions and the small volumes produced make it a rare vintage. It is a great vintage, with a strong identity.**

2025 is intense, deeply coloured, precise, with remarkable freshness. Nothing was forced, neither in the vineyard nor in the cellar.

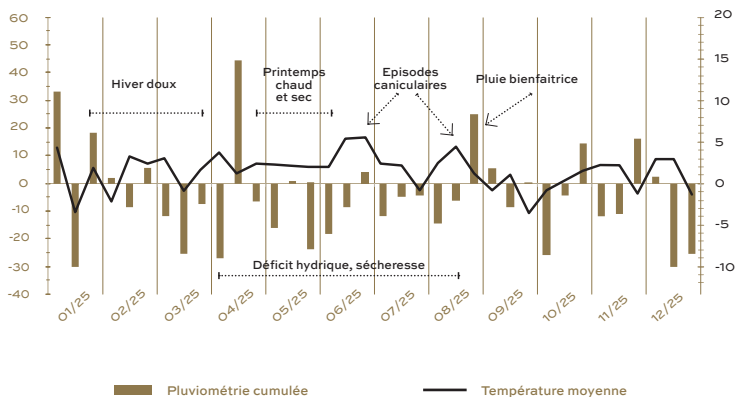

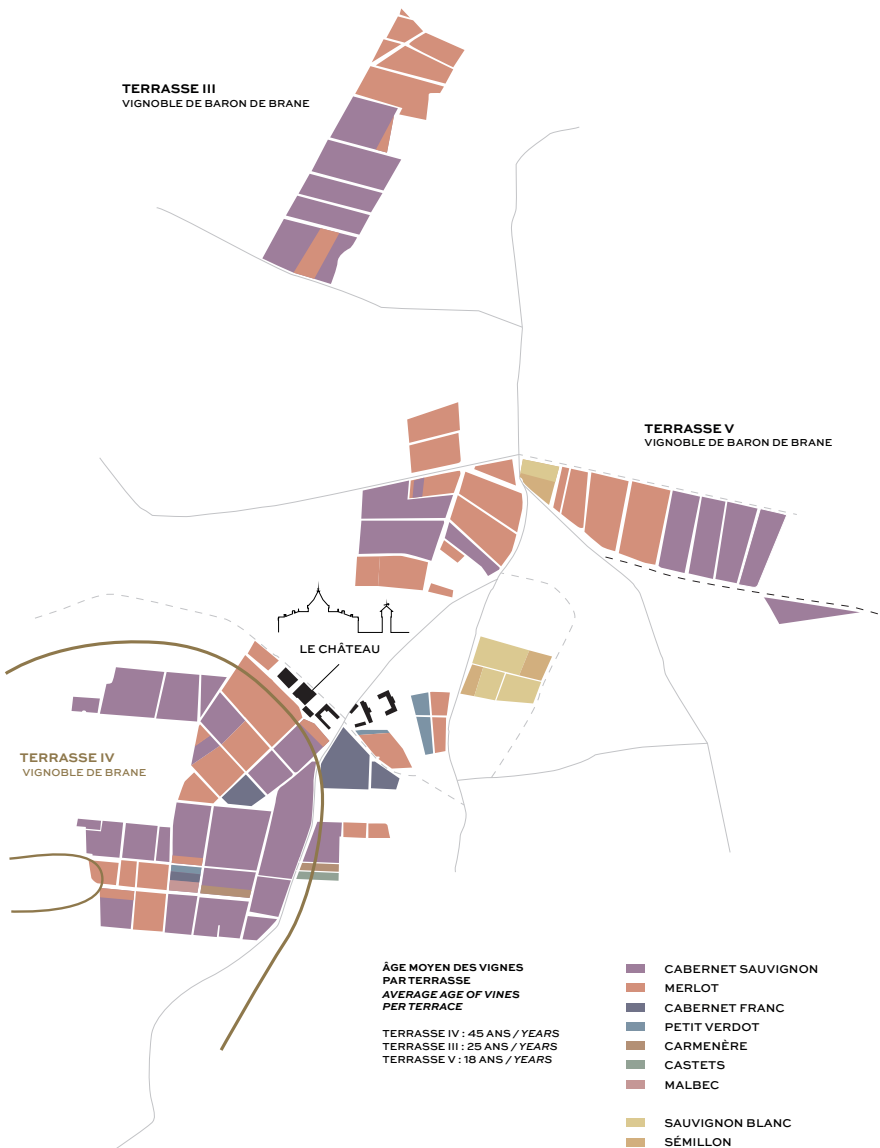
